BEYOND THE WALLS

What Happens Here Doesn't Stay Here

People hate change, but sometimes change is necessary. We have asked our parishioners to put up with so much this past year, and each one of you has been so patient and understanding. While we closed our old church doors at the end of October last year for a



7-week renovation, held and attended daily and weekly masses in gymnasium and Kindergarten room at the old St. Patrick School and you came anyway. Not a Mass was missed. We had to tack on an extra week while completed covering our kneelers and no complained. one When we opened up those same old doors in time for Advent, things had changed - a lot!

Since the 1970's, people have come to our office at what was once the clergy house and for many years has been the Pastoral Centre, when an office visit was necessary. To book Mass intentions, funeral arrangements, wedding or baptismal arrangements, or for a visit with the priest or their beloved Rita. And while you could still do all of those things, a few years ago it became the administrative building which housed all of the offices for staff. That too, no longer exists.

While the Pastoral Centre still stands, it doesn't serve as it used to. In January, the offices at the Pastoral Centre moved, when a building on Emerald St. S., owned by the Diocese of Hamilton, came available, was entirely renovated and in we moved. Our new Administrative Office building houses all of the staff and ministries of St. Patrick.

When De Mazenod Door Outreach first began, it too began out of the Pastoral Centre, but it quickly outgrew those walls and in 2016, the new De Mazenod Door Outreach opened in what is now the old St. Patrick School, until recently. With the school slated for demolition, we had to find new space that would be sufficient to last at least two to three years until the new St. Patrick School is erected.

With the Pastoral Centre now partially empty, it was renovated to suit our Outreach ministry, with a commercial kitchen and storage, and it was completed in time for the move from the school. In fact, we didn't miss a meal.



When COVID-19 was declared a pandemic, Masses were cancelled and churches were closed, and once again we had to make changes, but rose to the challenge. Online Mass has become a regular thing. Our paper bulletin is now accessible online in full colour. So little remains the same at our St. Patrick Parish of old. When we think of all that has changed this past year and how we've rolled with it and made it work for us, it's easy to realize that change is inevitable and so necessary. Sometimes we need to move to a different pew for a different view or to see an altered perspective. Change is healthy! Let's all be the change we wish to see in the world.

The move to the Pastoral Centre from the school was a pretty smooth transition, however it was originally a house where rooms had become offices. De Mazenod Door now takes up the entire front of the Pastoral Centre. There are large commercial-sized freezers and refrigeration units and two stoves, and these take up a good portion of space, but that isn't the issue. The issue is the heat generated by these units. We now realize that we are in need of a proper, commercial air conditioner with an outdoor compressor, that doesn't require ductwork and works in conjunction with the regular HVAC system. This past week has been unbearably hot everywhere, but specifically inside De Mazenod Door, and we are needing to leave doors open inside the Pastoral Centre, with fans running at night to keep the refrigeration system cool enough so that it doesn't get too hot and shut down. God bless our volunteers who have worked through it, wearing masks and PPE while it is so warm! We are in the midst of getting quotes, but we will need financial assistance to be able to purchase this. If you or anyone you know has a connection to someone in the HVAC industry, or if would like to contribute, we would love to hear from you!

In the meantime, we have been forging ahead, making new community friendships and partnerships. When the pandemic first began back in March, many moredonations were coming in and it didn't seem so worrisome, but as the sheen and luster wear off the pandemic, we're realizing that donations have really slowed down and it's now become crunch time. Remember when those of us who grew up in homes where money was tight, and our mothers made meals out of nothing every day? We're not there yet, thank goodness, and if we know nothing else, we know God will ensure that we will find a way! We are thankful every single day for the Oblate Mission and what it means for our commu-

nity and those we serve. We are ever so grateful that our marginalized remain first and foremost and are what keeps us centred, always wanting to do more.


