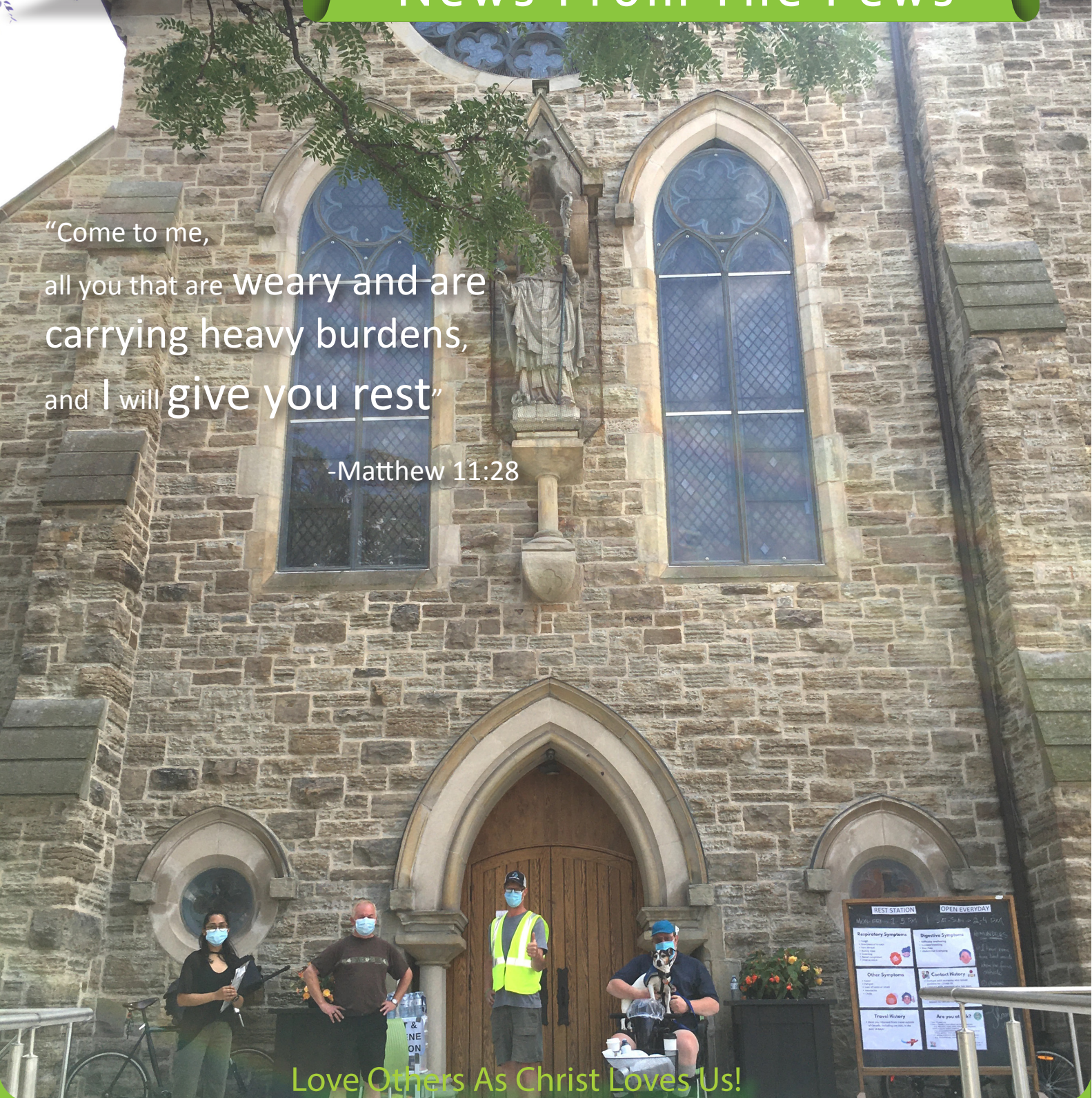

BEYOND THE WALLS

What Happens Here Doesn't Stay Here



Approximately 15 months ago there was a plea that went out from Fr. Tony's home parish in West St. Modeste, Newfoundland and Labrador, to their parishioners and friends. Their small church, Our Lady of Labrador Parish, built in 1958, was in need of some major structural repairs to the tune of almost \$80,000. These repairs were an absolute must before the long cold winter months, as the roof and other parts of the church were in very bad shape and already leaking. 'OLOL' as it is affectionately known to those who live and worship there, is a small parish located in West St. Modeste, a small town on the coast of Labrador with a booming population of 111 people, according to Census in 2016. They knew it would be virtually impossible to raise those funds on their own so reached out to friends and family, both near and far.

Both Fr. Tony and Fr. Jarek had been pastors in Labrador before coming to Hamilton and since Fr. Tony was born and raised in this area, and his Mom and family members still attend this church, he too heard the call.

We took up the challenge to see how we could help and before we knew it, our own parishioners, friends and family were on board with helping in a huge way. In early June, the staff started planning what we would do for Fr. Tony's birthday at the end of the month, and it just seemed fitting to collect a few dollars from each of our pastoral team that

wanted to contribute. As rumour spread of our birthday gift mission, many of our parish and De Mazenod Door Outreach volunteers were asking how they could help as well. Before we knew it, by the morning of June 30th, 2019 we had collected exactly \$4,000 in honour of his birthday – all to be donated to Our Lady of Labrador Parish in honour of Fr. Tony! We still remember the look of shock on his face when he opened his card and the envelope filled with cash. It was a beautiful and memorable moment. Although, it's always nice to get a new sweater or a bottle of your favourite scotch for your birthday, gifts that help others are the ones that make the greatest memories and leave the best footprints on your heart. It is indeed a wonderful memory.

Talk about 'beyond the walls'? When we completed the 'Our Lady of Labrador Parish project', we had collected over \$17,000 to help that small community have a place to pray and to worship with their families and those still to come. We spread that love that St. Patrick's is known for almost 3,000 km, but mostly we practiced what we preach day to day, to help those in need and to love others as Christ loves us.

Last Saturday the OLOL Parish presented Mrs. O'Dell, Fr. Tony's Mom, with a plaque, which is now hung in their church entrance, in his honour.

WE REALLY NEED YOUR HELP



Our church is now open and we need volunteers to help with the new cleaning protocols to keep everyone safe. We will provide all cleaning supplies and personal protective equipment, as well as complete training for different teams who will be assigned specific duties.

THIS IS AN URGENT REQUEST. Please see the list of duties we need teams for BEFORE AND AFTER EACH MASS:

SANCTUARY

- Wipe credence table
- Wipe all tables
- Wipe outside tabernacle
- Wipe presider chairs
- Wash floor
- Vestments should be washed after each Mass

NAVE

- Disinfect and wipe down all pews (front and back) including kneelers
- Disinfect all doors, light switches, tables, walls
- Mop floor
- Disinfect and wipe down all statues

SIDE ALTARS

- Musicians are responsible for cleaning and disinfecting all music equipment, microphones to be cleaned and sponged, mic protectors to be re-moved after each use and cleaned.

NARTHEX

- Disinfect all doors and handles
- Mop floors

BATHROOMS

- Clean and disinfect toilets, faucets and door handles after each use.

HAND SANITIZING AT THE ENTRANCE DOORS

- Offer hand sanitizer to all coming in the church

All of the above functions **MUST** be performed after each Mass, which means x's 4 Masses. If you are able to help with these tasks, please phone the office - 905 522 9828, and let them know you are available.

REST AND HYGIENE STATION - UPDATE AND APPEAL

It has been a few months now that the rest station has been running and serving the vulnerable of our community. Our guests have been so grateful that we have opened up the church for them to be able to rest and to access a restroom and the number of visits we get each day continues to increase. It has also been an amazing and humbling experience for our volunteers who have really gotten to know our guests and their stories.

Although Hamilton is in the beginnings of stage 2, there is still a great need for the rest station. As of this past Friday, the City of Hamilton removed the 6 portable toilets that were outside of Jackson Square at King and Bay. Many of the locations where washrooms were available before the pandemic, have yet to be reopened. That being said, we are in need of some supplies for our guests, namely toothpaste and toothbrushes, shampoo/conditioner, deodorant, new socks (mens and womens), new underwear (mens and womens) and women's hygiene products. If you are able to help us by donating some of these items, we would greatly appreciate it. Thank you in advance for your generosity!

Additionally, if you are interested in volunteering your time to help us run the rest station, we would love to have you! We are open on weekdays from 1-5 PM and weekends from 2-4 PM. Please contact JC Asuncion (jasuncion@stpatrickshamilton.ca) for more information.

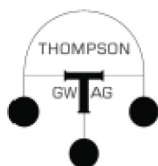
